The School

As a Texas Education Agency (TEA) approved non-public, non-profit school which serves children who are deaf or hard of hearing, as well as children with typical hearing. All children enrolled in the day-school program benefit from a research-based curriculum to develop both language and academic skills in an experience-based environment. Sunshine Cottage enriches the lives of children with hearing loss by improving listening, language, and speech programs. Every child in the San Antonio area, (and those from other states and international locations) are embraced by a dedicated staff and provided with the necessary skills to learn in a rich auditory-oral environment. All children and their families benefit from the outstanding educational environment and strong support system spanning their Sunshine Cottage experience.

The Position

In addition to serving as the educational leader of a remarkable Early Childhood and Elementary School program for students ages 3 to fifth grade, the next Executive Director will be responsible for all aspects of the Hearing Evaluation Center which offers diagnostic hearing evaluations for newborns through 6 month olds, a Parent-Infant Program for children at birth to three years of age, an Audiology department (identification, fitting and management of hearing technology) and a Speech-Language Therapy program.
